All participants must be at least 55 years of age by December 31 of the year of the games.

Note: The Mixed Doubles team may be created from the qualified women's and men's doubles, or can be a separate mixed doubles entry.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Bowls Canada Boulingrin rules are in effect.
2. Round-robin format will be used. The results at the end of the Round-robin will determine the medalists.
3. Games will consist of 12 ends for both age categories.
4. There will be two points awarded for a win and zero points for a loss.
5. Ties at the end of a game will be played off with an extra end.
6. If two or more teams are tied after the round robin, the aggregate shots against each team will be divided into the aggregate shots it has scored. The team with the highest result shall be declared the winner.
7. At the start of the tournament, a trial end for each team is permitted, and one burnt end per team per game is permitted.
8. Clothing will be the traditional white or cream, or the provincial/territorial colours.
